From biodynamically grown grapes. Drink or hold.

A truly astonishing and really dramatic Saint Romain. Deep aromas of Amalfi lemons, toasted nuts and smoke. Juicy and minerally with a fabulous concentration and silkiness of texture. Unbelievable length and complexity for a village wine. From biodynamically grown grapes. Drink or hold.

CORTON GRAND CRU LES RENARDES 2022

The fabulous and enveloping nose of summer flowers pulls you into this great Corton. Sensational concentration and finesse combine to make this extraordinary wine so compelling. More than enough red fruit and delicate savory character. Then the super-long, silky finish sweeps you away. From biodynamically grown grapes. 60% whole cluster fermentation. Matured in small oak barrels for 12 months. Drinkable now, but best from 2025.

Here's a lightning-bright Corton. A super-elegant wine with crisp pear fruit and sage freshness. So much energy and drive, plus a radical chalky minerality that drives this over the medium- to full-bodied palate at a very brisk clip. Very crisp in the long finish. From biodynamically grown grapes. Drink or hold.

CORTON GRAND CRU LE ROGNET-ET-CORTON 2022

This seriously structured, beautifully balanced Corton has striking aromas of wild herbs, bergamot, fresh red plums and a touch of baking spices, the red berry fruit currently in the background. Great concentration on the medium-bodied palate, and the radical minerality we expect from this site, but the long finish is very elegant. From biodynamically grown grapes. 60% whole-cluster fermentation. Matured in small oak barrels for 12 months. Drinkable now, but best from 2025.
